Andrew Snyder has been the Program Director for DSP since November 2021.

Prior to joining DSP Andrew practiced law in Austin, Texas. He still works with the Travis County Probate Court, serving as attorney ad litem and assisting with uncontested cases. Immediately following law school, Andrew had a fellowship with the Constitutional Law Center for Muslims in America, a nonprofit whose mission was to assist indigent Muslims with all manner of legal matters. While there he participated in law enforcement interviews with clients, drafted Continuing Legal Education Courses for fellow attorneys, and assisted with trial preparation.

Subsequently, Andrew moved to Austin, Texas to join the Carlton Law Firm, a public utilities firm. There he represented rate payers in suits against the Public Utility Commission, helped rural communities establish fire houses and hospitals, and negotiated with landholders to purchase property throughout Texas.
